RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RESOLUTION OF INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE LOS ALAMITOS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT TO ESTABLISH THE SCHOOL FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE LOS ALAMITOS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT AND TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN OTHER ACTIONS

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Part 10, Division 1, Title 1 (commencing with Section 15300) of the Education Code (the "Act") provides for the formation of school facilities improvement districts consisting of a portion of the territory within a school district for the issuance of general obligation bonds by a school facilities improvement district; and

WHEREAS, for the purposes of financing improvements at certain schools and facilities as authorized under the provisions of the Act and Education Code Sections 15100 and 15264 et seq., the Los Alamitos Unified School District (the "District"), on its own initiative, has established a school facilities improvement district within the boundaries of the District known as the "School Facilities Improvement District No. 1 of the Los Alamitos Unified School District" (the "Improvement District")

WHEREAS, in connection with the formation of the Improvement District, the District Board of Education (the "Board"), on April 22, 2008, adopted a Resolution of Intention ("Original Resolution of Intention") to form the Improvement District and determined that the cost of facility improvements within the Improvement District was approximately \$126 million; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the District has additional facility needs in the Improvement District and desires to amend the Original Resolution of Intention through the adoption of this Resolution ("Amended Resolution of Intention");

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE LOS ALAMITOS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER as follows:

- Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- Section 2.** Improvement District No. 1 was formed to facilitate the issuance of general obligation bonds on behalf of Improvement District No. 1 to finance the costs of school facilities (the "Facilities") to be acquired, repaired, constructed and equipped within the Improvement District No. 1 consistent with the requirements set forth in Education Code Sections 15100 and 15264 et seq.
- Section 3.** The Board has determined that the estimated cost of the Facilities will be approximately \$265 million. A description of the Facilities is set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto.
- Section 4.** It is the intention of the Board to levy an annual tax in an amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the general obligation bonds to be issued on behalf of the Improvement District No. 1 in one or more series to finance the cost of the Facilities. Such tax will be levied exclusively upon the lands in Improvement District No. 1 for the purpose of repaying the general obligation bonds issued by the District on behalf of the Improvement District No. 1.
- Section 5.** A public hearing (the "Hearing") on the increased costs of facility improvements of the Improvement District No. 1 shall be held on June 19, 2018 at 4 p.m., or as soon thereafter as practicable, at 10293 Bloomfield Street, Los Alamitos, California 90720. At the time and place set forth above for the Hearing, the Board will receive testimony as to increase in estimated costs of the facility improvements.

At the time and place set forth above for the Hearing, any interested person, including all persons owning lands in the Los Alamitos Unified School District or in Improvement District No. 1 may appear and be heard.

**Section 6.** The Secretary is directed to cause to be published a notice (the "Notice") of the Hearing and pursuant to Section 6066 of the Government Code once a week for two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in Orange County. Such Notice shall contain the text of this Amended Resolution of Intention and shall be first published at least 14 days prior to the date fixed for the Hearing.

**Section 8.** This Amended Resolution of Intention shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
