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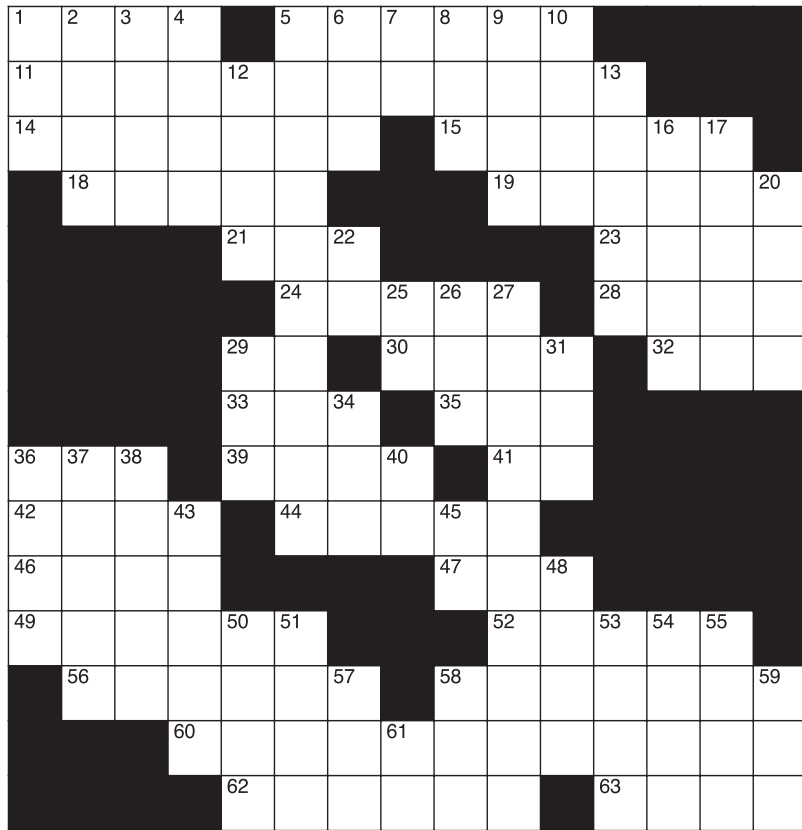
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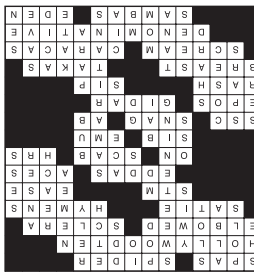

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on September 17, 2018 the City Council of the City of Los Alamitos adopted Ordinance No. 2018-06, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALAMITOS, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT (ZOA) 18-02 TO REPEAL SECTIONS 16.19.030 AND 17.34.060(B)(6) REGARDING PARKING STANDARDS FOR CONDOMINIUM CONVERSIONS, AND REPLACE EACH WITH SECTION 17.26.065, AND FURTHER AMEND TITLE 17 OF THE LOS ALAMITOS MUNICIPAL CODE TO MODIFY OFF-STREET PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR MULTIPLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL USES IN THE R-2 (LIMITED MULTIPLE-FAMILY) AND R-3 (MULTIPLE-FAMILY) RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICTS AND DEFINE "TANDEM PARKING."

The Planning Commission held several noticed Public Hearings to where it reviewed clarified and revised parking standards, pertaining to storage, tandem parking, garage standards, and other minor changes. The Planning Commission recommended the City Council adopt a Zoning Ordinance Amendment 18-02 to amend parking requirements.

Zoning Ordinance Amendment 18-02 will amend the following sections of Title 17 of the Los Alamitos Municipal Code (LAMC):

- Section 17.26.030 to generally prohibit tandem parking for consideration to meet parking standards;
- Section 17.26.060 to require fully enclosed garages with functioning garage door openers for some parking requirements;
- Sections 17.26.075 and 17.26.080 to clarify exterior open space parking requirements for residential and commercial parking;
- Section 17.34.060 to reflect specific standards for condominiums; and,
- Section 17.76.020 to add tandem parking to the definitions section of the Zoning Code.

Zoning Ordinance Amendment 18-02 will also repeal sections 16.19.030 and 17.34.050(B)(6) to remove duplicate language in the LAMC, and replace both sections with section 17.26.065 to provide residential condominium conversion parking standards. The enactment of these off-street parking requirements can further preserve the public safety, health, and welfare of the R-2 and R-3 Zoning Districts.
