DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The JANICE LYNN STREET AT MYRA AVENUE STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENT, CIP Project No. 217 is located on Janice Lynn Street at Myra Avenue towards south for about one hundred and twenty-five (125) feet in the City of Cypress. It consists of four (4) main tasks.

The **first task** is to obtain tickets from Underground Service Alert (USA) for identifying all the underground utilities within the project site and protect them during the construction. The Contractor shall coordinate with the utility owners for relocating their respective facilities, and shall prepare and implement Water Pollution Control Program (WP-CP) and traffic control plans throughout the construction. Any existing improvement damaged by the construction of this project will be removed and replaced by the Contractor to the current City standards at no additional cost to the City of Cypress.

The **second task** is to remove and reconstruct portion of the existing sewer house connection laterals to the precise lines and grades for matching the existing sewer system and to meet the requirements as shown on the City and Standard Plans for Public Works Construction (SPPWC) standard plans.

The **third task** is to construct about 111 feet of 24-inch reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) storm drain system with two 18-inch RCP laterals and catch basins to precise line and grade shown on the design plans on Janice Lynn Street. Contractor's attention is directed to the fact that asbestos cement water pipes and other utilities may be shallow and subject to damage due to heavy construction equipment. The Contractor shall conduct its operations so as not to damage the existing utilities or street curb and gutters. The Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damage to the utilities and facilities.

The **fourth task** is to grind the top two (2) inches of asphalt concrete (AC) pavement and overlay back of full street width along Janice Lynn Street. The total length of the street pavement area from gutter to gutter is about one-hundred and twenty-five (125) feet.
