

The bids will be publicly opened and read at 2:00 p.m. on the 3rd day of January, 2019, in the Los Alamitos City Hall Council Chambers.

The City of Los Alamitos proposes to Custom fabricate and install ARS-CL™ storm water protection screens in the City's 117 catch basins (CBs) listed below. These storm water protection screens are certified for installation throughout the State. Funding for this project utilizes OCTA's master purchase agreement with OCPW, MA-080-15011198 for Trash and Debris Capture Devices for the City of Alamitos OCTA ECP grant application for 2018-19.

Copies of the plans, specifications, and contract documents are available from the City of Los Alamitos, 3191 Katella Avenue, Los Alamitos, CA 90720 upon payment of a \$15.00 non-refundable fee if picked up, or payment of a \$25.00 non-refundable fee if mailed. In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, and Business and Professions Code 7028.15(e), the Agency has determined that the contractor shall posses a valid Class A contractor's license at the time that the contract is awarded. Failure to possess the specified license shall render a bidder's bid as non-responsive and shall bar award of the contract to any bidder not possessing the specified license at the time of the award

CONTRACTORS ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE LI-CENSED AND REGULATED BY THE CONTRACT-ORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD, ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING A CONTRACTOR MAY BE RE-FERRED TO THE REGISTRAR, CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD, P.O. BOX 2600, SACRAMENTO,

CA 95826. At the time the contract is awarded, the contractor shall be properly licensed in accordance with the laws of this state. The first payment for work or material shall not be made unless and until the Registrar of Contractors verifies to the Agency that the records of the Contractors' State License Board indicate that the contractor was properly licensed at the time the contract was awarded. Any bidder or contractor not so licensed shall be subject to all legal penalties imposed by law including, but not limited to, any appropriate disciplinary action by the Contractors' State Board. Failure of the bidder to obtain proper and adequate licensing for an award of a contract shall constitute a failure to execute the contract and shall result in the forfeiture of the security of the bidder. (Public Contract Code § 20103.5)

Bids must be prepared on the approved bid forms in conformance with INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS and submitted in the envelopes provided, sealed and plainly marked on the outside:

The bid must be accompanied by a bid guarantee in the amount of 10% of the total bid by 2:00 p.m. ON THE DATE ADVERTISED FOR THE OPENING OF BIDS. More specifically, pursuant to Public Contract Code §§ 20170 and 20171, all bids for the project shall be presented, under sealed cover and shall be accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid: (a) cash; (b) a cashier's check made payable to the City of Los Alamitos; (c) a certified check made payable to the City of Los Alamitos; or (d) a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer made payable to the City of Los Alamitos. Such security shall be forfeited should the successful bidder to whom the contract is awarded fails to timely execute the contract and to deliver the necessary bonds and insurance certificates as specified in the

To the extent applicable, at any time during the term of the Agreement for the proposed project, the successful bidder may, at its own expense, substitute securities equivalent to the amount withheld as retention (or the retained percentage) in accordance with Public Contract Code § 22300.

Pursuant to California Civil Code § 3247, a payment bond is required to be submitted for all projects estimated in excess of \$25,000.00.

The Agency has determined that the proposed project is a public works subject to the provisions of Labor Code § 1720 thereby requiring the Contractor to pay the prevailing wage rates for all work performed under the Con-
