Description: Amendments to Chapter 15A. Cypress currently regulates massage establishments within its jurisdiction pursuant to Chapter 15A of the Municipal Code ("Chapter 15A"). The proposed ordinance amends Chapter 15A by updating regulations concerning ownership and operation of massage establishments, including massage technicians/practitioners certification requirements. The proposed ordinance also makes other technical changes to Chapter 15A.

Amendments to the Cypress Zoning Code. The proposed ordinance changes the Zoning Code relating to conditional use permit requirements for massage establishments in Cypress (e.g., requirements relating to the distance between massage establishments) and also creates an amortization period for such establishments. The proposed ordinance also makes technical changes to the Zoning Code. Adoption of Chapter 15A Fees. The City Council will

consider a resolution adopting deposit-based fees relating to (1) review, investigation, and processing of mas-sage establishment license and operator permit new/renewal applications and (2) appeals under Chapter 15A.
