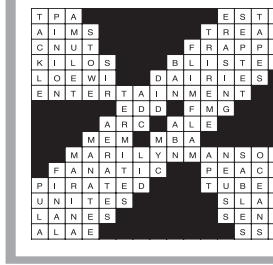
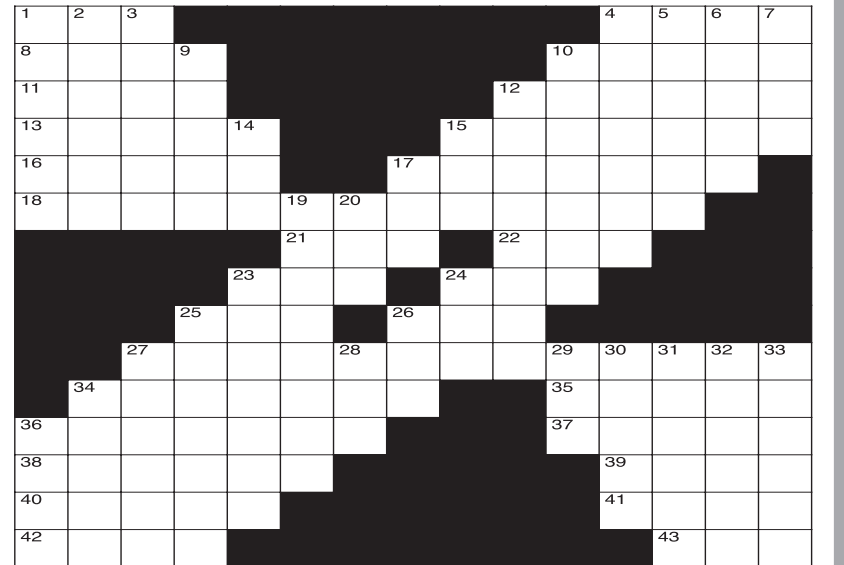

The Subdivision Code (Title 16) establishes regulations for the subdivision of real properties.
