Mr. Banner submitted applications for a General Plan Amendment (GPA 19-01B) and Zoning Map Amendment (ZOA 19-01) requesting approval to change the General Plan land use designation from Planned Industrial to Professional Office and the zoning designation from Planned Light Industrial (P-M) to Commercial Professional Office (C-O) for the property located at 4281 Katella Avenue. The subject site is developed with an 81,216 square foot office building and associated parking areas encompassing four parcels (APN 241-241-20, 241-241-21, 241-241-25 & 241-241-26), which comprise 3.9 acres. A Zoning map amendment has the effect of rezoning property from one zoning district to another. This application requests a rezoning of the parcel from the Planned Light Industrial (P-M) Zoning District to the Commercial Professional Office (C-O) Zoning District. The requested change does not involve a zoning text amendment. This process required a resolution of the Planning Commission recommending approval of the change. City Council adoption of the Ordinance will approve the requested Zoning Ordinance Amendment.
