Election Results: Two new members to join LAUSD Board of Education

The Los Alamitos Unified School District Board of Education will have two new members after the November 3, 2020 election. It was the first election for the district under its new trustee area voting system adopted earlier this year.

The Board of Education sets policy for nine public schools which are located in Los Alamitos, Rossmoor, and Seal Beach. The district is now divided into five trustee areas.

Former principal and 40-year Rossmoor resident Chris Forehan was elected to represent Trustee Area 2 which includes Weaver and Lee Elementary schools.

Scott Fayette, a former substitute and intervention teacher in LAUSD and current PTA Vice President at McAuliffe Middle school, will be appointed to represent Trustee Area 4 which covers parts of Seal Beach. Fayette's appointment comes after no one else filed papers to run for

Meg Cutuli has served on the Board for 20 years and was reelected to represent Trustee Area 5, which includes McGaugh Elementary school in Seal Beach.

"It is my honor to continue to serve the children of the communities of Seal Beach, Rossmoor and Los Alamitos. The support I have received is humbling," Cutuli wrote in an email.

Cutuli defeated retired engineer Matt Filler 62% to 38%, according to unofficial election results from the Orange County Registrar of Voters as of Nov. 9.

In the Trustee Area 2 race, Forehan won with 44% of the vote. Second-place finisher Paurvi Trivedi trailed him by more than 300 votes while Jody L. Roubanis had 18% of the vote.

"Thank you to the voters in Trustee Area #2," Forehan wrote in a statement to the Event-News Enterprise. "I plan to use my 38 years in public education to continue to make a difference for all students, their families and our wonderful community. I will be ready to start on Day #1."Joining Forehan as a first-time Board member is Fayette, who will be the only trustee with children currently attending LAUSD schools. He has a son at McAuliffe and another son attends Los Alamitos High School.

In an interview this week, Fayette said that was part of what motivated him to run for the seat. "I'm here as a conduit for all of the parents and the students," he said and added, "I don't know if parents and students get as big of a voice as they should.'

Current Board President Cutuli welcomed the new Board members. "I am looking forward to working with them and continuing to do great work for our students."

A large part of that work will likely focus on meeting the needs of the district's nearly 10,000 students amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

LAUSD was the first public school district in Orange County to be granted a waiver to allow students back inside classrooms in September. All campuses are currently in a hybrid-learning model where a limited number of students attend in-person classes for part of the day.

LAUSD is also administering an online-only education pathway known as LosAl@Home.

The school year has gone relatively smoothly but it hasn't been without challenges. In late September, teachers at Los Alamitos High School threatened a walkout just days before the campus was due to welcome back students. The admin-

istration and teachers came to an agreement about concerns regarding health and safety protocols for in-person learning in time to avoid any disruptions to the reopening.

According to numbers posted by the district on Nov. 9, LAUSD currently has 18 confirmed COVID-19 cases. That represents 13 students and 5 staff members or .214% of the in-person population.

Cutuli, Fayette, and Forehan will be sworn in at the December 15 Board meeting. They will officially begin their four-year terms after the

swearing-in.

Board of Education members Karen Russell and David Boyer did not seek re-election after each serving 16 years, according to a statement from LAUSD Superintendent Dr. Andrew Pulver.

"They have been faithful, dedicated advocates for the students, staff and families of Los Alamitos Unified," Pulver wrote of Russell and Boyer.

Board members Diana Hill and Marlys Davidson are up for reelection in 2022.

State officials, other systems seek LAUSD advice

Assemblyman Patrick O'Donnell, Education Chair, tours schools Monday

Reports have been circulating that Los Angeles and Long Beach school systems have been in meetings with Los Alamitos Unified School District officials in recent weeks.

The Event News Enterprise has reached out to Dr. Andrew Pulver, Superintendent, for additional details, but sources say LAUSD is working with a number of state officials and other systems to establish key reference points.

As part of that effort, LAUSD Vice President Marlys Davidson said Assemblyman Patrick O'Donnell, did confirm that he toured several elementary schools with Pulver, LAUSD Board President Meg Cutuli and Assistant Supt. Ondrea Reed on Monday.

Davidson, who also attended the event, said O'Donnell is somewhat of a native having grown up in Rossmoor and he attended Hopkinson Elementary.

She said O'Donnell wanted to know what some of the techniques and protocols developed in Los Alamitos Unified might look like in other systems. "He was very thankful to Dr. Pulver," said Davidson.

"It makes me very happy to see all of the hard work done by everyone in Los Al Unified has been validated," said Davidson, a retired teacher. "They deserve that."

She said the collaborative effort between Dr. Pulver, Reed, the board,

the parents, teachers, administrators and "even the custodians who work all night to keep the schools sanitized," deserve the credit.

"None of this is easy," she said.

The topic was expected to be discussed in more detail at Tuesday's LAUSD Board of Education meeting and the ENE will follow up with additional details next week.

Newman leads Chang for 29th State Senate

Democrat Josh Newman is holding a slight lead in the race to take back the 29th California State Senate seat he was recalled from in 2018. Newman held nearly a three-point lead over incumbent Ling Ling Chang, as of Monday night's update, according to the California Secretary of State website. Newman had 205,049 votes to Chang's 194,195.

The 29th California State Senate district covers mostly areas of Orange County, starting from Cypress and La Palma, and running northeast into parts of Los Angeles and Riverside County areas. Newman defeated Chang in the 2016 general election for the 29th seat, by slightly less than

Newman was removed by a controversial recall effort in 2018, after he was one of 81 state legislators who voted to increase a state gas tax to pay for road improvements and transportation projects. 58 percent of voters voted to remove him, and 38 percent voted to replace him with Chang.

Newman is endorsed by the California Teacher's Association, the Sierra Club, Planned Parenthood and the National Union of Healthcare Workers, among others. Chang is endorsed by the Howard Jarvis Taxpayers Association, as well as three members each from the La Palma (Peter Kim, Nitesh Patel and Michelle Steggell) and Cypress City Council (Rob Johnson, Stacy Berry and Jon Peat).
