A Zoning Ordinance Amendment (ZOA 21-01) to Title 17 of the Los Alamitos Municipal Code. Since approval of the November 2019 zoning code (Title 17) update, the City has identified sections that need to be clarified. These clarifications will be considered by the Planning Commission, and if the Commission approves of the changes to the code, the changes will be considered for approval by the City Council at an upcoming meeting.

Adopt Planning Commission Resolution No. 21-04, entitled, "A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LOS ALAMITOS, CALIFORNIA, RECOMMENDING THE CITY COUNCIL TO ADOPT ORDINANCE NO. 2021-TBD AMENDING TITLE 17 (ZONING) OF THE LOS ALAMITOS MUNICIPAL CODE TO CORRECT CLERICAL ERRORS AND OMISSIONS AND TO MAINTAIN INTERNAL CONSISTENCY (ZOA 21-01) (CITY INITIATED)."

Environmental Determination: The proposed use is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b) (3) – the project is covered by the general rule that the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) applies only to projects, which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA.

The Department Secretary will compile a list of speakers who have indicated a desire to speak. Before the close of the Public Hearing, the Department Secretary will announce each speaker, enable the speaker's microphone, and begin the three minute timer. The speaker's microphone will automatically be disabled at the end of three minutes.

All speakers shall observe civility, decorum and good behavior. Any item submitted to the Planning Commission during the meeting shall become public record and subject to applicable disclosure laws.

If you challenge the decision of any of the actions listed above in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised in written or emailed correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the Public Hearing. PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Los Alamitos as AGENCY, invites sealed bids for the above stated project and will receive such bids in the office of the City Clerk, **3191 Katella Avenue, Los Alamitos, CA 90720** up to the hour of 11:00 a.m., on the 23rd day of March 2021. The bids will be publicly opened and read at 11:00 a.m. on the 23rd day of March 2021, in the Los Alamitos City Hall Council Chambers.

The City of Los Alamitos proposes to cold mill and construct ARHM overlay, construct curb ramps, construct sidewalk, construct curb and gutter, adjust valves, and adjust manholes on Howard Avenue from Reagan Street to Maple Street. In addition, the project will also include signing and striping. Existing curbs and private facilities will be protected in place within the limits of the project unless otherwise shown. Copies of the plans, specifications, and contract documents are available from the City of Los Alamitos, **3191 Katella Avenue, Los Alamitos, CA 90720** upon payment of a **\$15.00 non-refundable fee if picked up, or payment of a \$25.00 non-refundable fee if mailed.** In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, and Business and Professions Code § 7028.15(e), the Agency has determined that the contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor's license at the time that the contract is awarded. Failure to possess the specified license shall render a bidder's bid as non-responsive and shall bar award of the contract to any bidder not possessing the specified license at the time of the award.

Pursuant to California Civil Code § 3247, a payment bond is required to be submitted for all projects estimated in excess of \$25,000.00.

The Agency has determined that the proposed project is a public works subject to the provisions of Labor Code § 1720 thereby requiring the Contractor to pay the prevailing wage rates for all work performed under the Contract.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 11:00 a.m. on March 9, 2021.

This is a federally assisted construction contract. Federal labor standards provisions outlined in the HUD-4010 form, including the prevailing wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (DBRA), will be enforced. No employee, officer, or agent of the sub-recipient shall participate in the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported by federal funds if a conflict of interest, real or apparent, would be involved.
