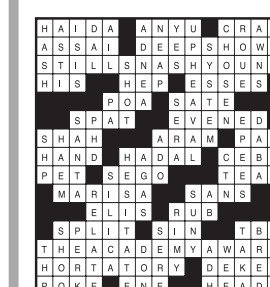

2. A maximum of four (4) female chickens, or hens, may be kept on a residential parcel.
3. All hen chickens must be confined in a pen, coop, cage, run or other enclosure at all times. Such enclosures must include nesting boxes with a minimum area of three (3) square feet per hen.
4. All hen chickens shall be provided with adequate food, water, and ventilation.
5. Chicken pens, coops, cages, runs or other enclosures must be kept in a clean and sanitary condition, with feathers, manure or other debris removed daily and stored in an air-tight container prior to disposal.
6. Chicken feed must be stored properly to prevent spoilage and to prevent access to other animals and rodents.
7. All hen chickens shall be kept within an enclosure that is at least twenty (20) feet distant from any dwelling unit on an adjacent parcel.
8. No hen chickens may be kept in the front yard.

NOTICE INVITING BIDS: Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the City Engineer, La Palma, California, until **11:00 AM on Thursday, May 26, 2022** for furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment for **HOUSTON AVENUE CITY PROJECT NO. ST-364, CRESCENT AVENUE CITY PROJECT NO. ST-366 AND ZONE 5 SLURRY SEAL IMPROVEMENTS, CITY PROJECT NO. ST-365** (the "Project").

The Bids shall be submitted to the City Engineer, City of La Palma, 7821 Walker Street, La Palma, California 90623-1771, in a sealed envelope plainly marked on the outside "**BID: for HOUSTON AVENUE CITY PROJECT NO. ST-364, CRESCENT AVENUE CITY PROJECT NO. ST-366 AND ZONE 5 SLURRY SEAL IMPROVEMENTS CITY PROJECT NO. ST-365, to be opened on Thursday, May 26, 2022 at 11:00 AM.**" The proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud in the office of the City Engineer at the aforementioned time on the aforementioned date. DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The work includes Houston Avenue Slurry Seal (Type II) from Moody Street to Walker Street, Crescent Avenue Slurry Seal (Type II) from city limits to city limits and Residential Maintenance Zone 5 Slurry Seal. The work also includes sidewalk repairs, removal and installation of new street water valve boxes, concrete fill unused tree well, 2" grind and overlay at various locations, ADA ramp replacement and Micro Milling.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Contractors requesting to offer substitutions shall provide all product substitutions five (5) days prior to bid for consideration by the City prior to Bid. Substitutions will not be considered by the City after bids have been received.

COMPLETION OF WORK: The project shall be completed within "FORTY-FIVE (45)" consecutive working days (Monday – Friday), beginning on the date stipulated in the written Notice-to-Proceed issued by the City Engineer. Failure to complete the Work within the time set forth herein will result in the imposition of liquidated damages for each day of delay, in the amount set forth in the Information for Bidders.

MANDATORY BIDDERS CONFERENCE: All bidders must attend a bidder's conference on **May 17, 2022 at 11:00 a.m.**, to be held at La Palma Community Center Fan Palm Room at 7821 Walker Street, La Palma, CA 90623. **All proposals received from Bidders not in attendance at the Bidders Conference shall be deemed non-responsive and shall be rejected.**

OBTAINING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS: Plans, Specifications, and any project addenda are available for download on the city's website, www.cityoflapalma.org. All prospective bidders are responsible for checking the City's website for the issuance of any project addenda prior to the bid opening for inclusion as part of the bid proposal. BONDS: Pursuant to the Instructions to Bidders, each proposal shall be accompanied by cash or by a cashier's or certified check or by a bid bond in the amount of **ten percent (10%)** of the amount of the bid price payable to the City of La Palma as a guarantee that the bidder, if his or her proposal is accepted, will promptly execute the contract, secure payment of workers' compensation insurance and furnish a satisfactory **faithful performance bond** in the amount of **one hundred percent (100%)** of the total bid price and a **labor and material bond** in the amount of **one hundred percent (100%)** of the total bid price.

SUBSTITUTION OF SECURITIES: The Contractor may substitute securities for any monies withheld by the City to ensure performance under the contract in compliance with the requirements of Public Contract Code Section 22300 and the "Substitution of Securities" provisions of the General Provisions.

WAGE RATES: As required by Section 1773 of the California Labor Code, the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations of the State of California has determined the general prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which Work is scheduled to be performed. Copies of the wage rate determinations, entitled PREVAILING WAGE SCALE, are maintained at the La Palma City Hall, 7822 Walker Street, La Palma, California, and are available to any interested party upon request. The Contractor shall post a copy of this document at each job site. The Contractor and any subcontractor under it shall pay not less than the specified prevailing rates of wages to all workers employed in the execution of the Contract.

CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE: In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code Section 3300, the City requires that the bidder possess the following classification of contractor's license at the time that the bid proposal is submitted: **Class A.** If the license classification specified hereinabove is that of a "specialty contractor" as defined in Section 7058 of the California Business and Professions Code, the specialty contractor awarded the Contract for this Work shall itself construct a majority of the Work, in accordance with the provisions of California Business and Professions Code Section 7059. Each bidder shall clearly write or type their contractor's license number on the outside of the bidding envelope.

CONTRACTORS REGISTRATION: In accordance with the provisions of Labor Code section 1771.1, a contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to (a) bid on or be listed in a bid proposal or (b) engage in the performance of this Work, unless currently registered and qualified to perform the Work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.

COMPLIANCE MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT: Contractor's performance of the Work described in this Notice Inviting Bids is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the California Department of Industrial Relations.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY: The City hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of sex, race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
