The District has obtained from the Department of Industrial Relations the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work for each trade, craft, classification, or type of work needed to execute the contract. Holiday rates shall be paid as specified in the collective bargain.

ing agreement applicable to each particular trade, craft classification, or type of work employed on the project Copies of schedules of rates so determined are available on the Internet at (http://www.dir.ca.gov/oprl/ DPreWageDetermination.htm) and are on file and avail-able at the District Office address noted above. In accordance with Section 1773.2 of the California Labor Code, the Contractor shall post a copy of the determination of prevailing rate of wages at each jobsite. The schedule of per diem wages is based upon a working day of eight (8) hours. The rate for holiday and overtime work shall be at time plus one-half. The Contractor and any subcontractor(s) shall pay not less than the specified prevailing rates of wages to all workers employed by them in the execution of the contract. In accordance with provisions of the Public Contract Code Section 22300, substitution of eligible and equivalent securities

for any monies withheld to ensure performance under this contract will be permitted at the request and expense of the Contractor. G. All bidders and their subcontractors MUST be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and possess a current and valid DIR registration number at the time of bid submission. H. No Bid may be withdrawn until ninety (90) days after the Bid Opening Date.
