THE AUTUMN FESTIVALS BEGIN

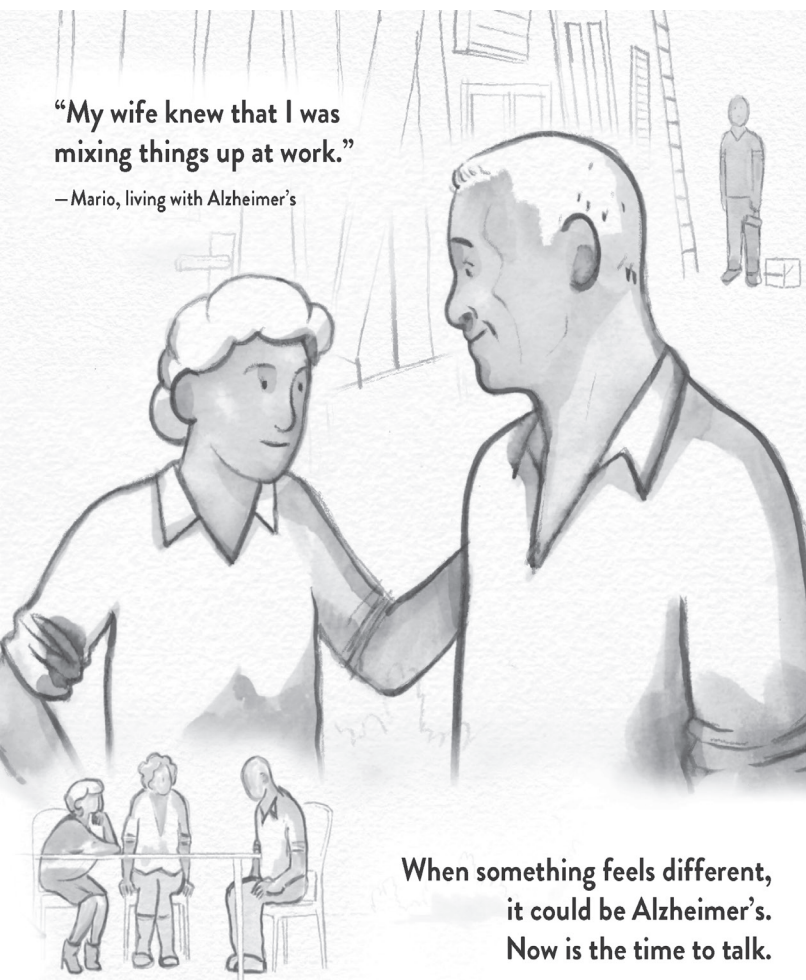
