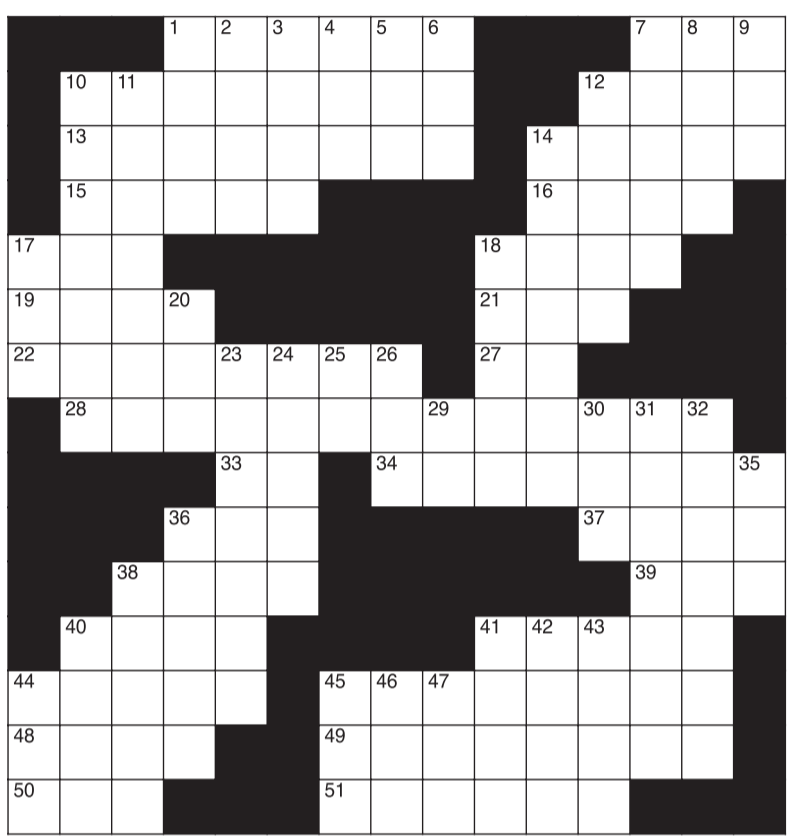
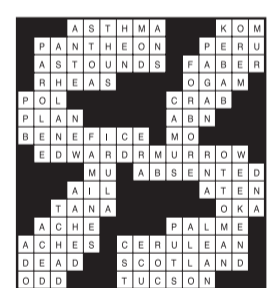

The City's Municipal Code does not currently allow for the use or sale of safe and sane fireworks. The proposed Ordinance would establish regulations governing the sale, use, and discharge of safe and sane fireworks within City limits.

Only "safe and sane" fireworks are sold in California for private use because they are considered less dangerous to individuals and pose less of a risk of causing fire and damage to property. Safe and sane fireworks do not fly, explode, shoot projectiles, travel, or leave the ground, and such fireworks usually exclude very large fireworks of other dangerous devices like rockets and aerial shells.
