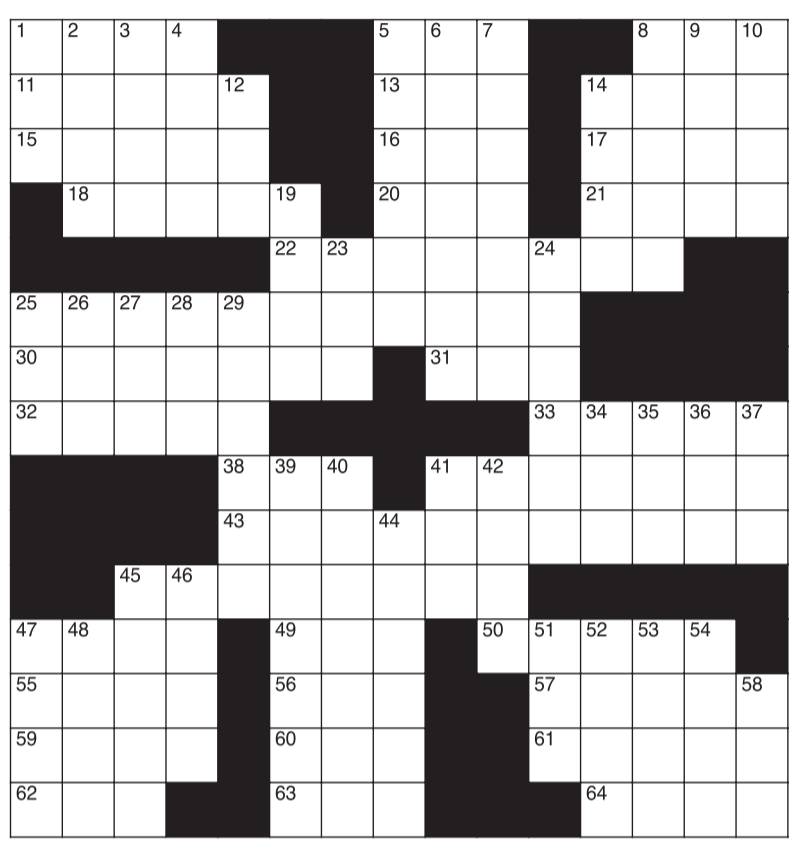

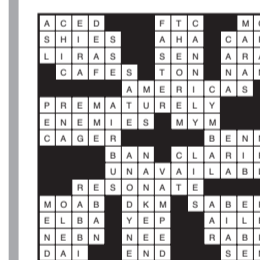

**ORDINANCE NO. 44 AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ROSSMOOR/LOS ALAMITOS AREA SEWER DISTRICT CONTINUING AND EXTENDING SEWER USER RATES AND CHARGES AT THE RATES ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 42 FOR FY 23-24.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the County Water District Law, Water Code 30000 et seq., the Rossmoor/Los Alamitos Area Sewer District ("District") has the authority to adopt ordinances relating to the provision of sewer services and facilities, and regulations of those services and facilities. WHEREAS, Health & Safety Code Section 5470 et seq. further authorizes the District to adopt fees and charges for the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, maintenance, and operation of sanitary sewer system facilities. WHEREAS, the Regional Water Quality Control Board for the Santa Ana Region adopted Order R8-2002-0014, which prescribes general waste discharge requirements prohibiting sanitary sewer overflows and other maintenance and operational requirements by sewer collection agencies (Waste Discharge Requirements). WHEREAS, the Federal Clean Water Act and the Waste Discharge Requirements require each governmental entity that operates a sanitary sewer system in the watershed to maintain and replace its sanitary sewer system infrastructure in the manner necessary to prevent sewage spills. WHEREAS, sewage spills are harmful to the public health and the environment. WHEREAS, the Waste Discharge Requirements mandate the adequate funding for proper management, operation, and maintenance of the sanitary sewer system. WHEREAS, the District intends to ensure that sufficient revenues are collected to adequately manage, operate, and maintain its sanitary sewer system facilities. WHEREAS, the Government Accounting Standards Board now requires that maintenance of infrastructure be accounted for and that reserves be in place to maintain such infrastructure (GASB 34). WHEREAS, on June 10, 2019, the District adopted Ordinance No. 42 establishing a wastewater service charge on properties served by the District to maintain its infrastructure to comply with the foregoing State regulatory requirements, with said rates and charges required to raise sufficient revenue to fund operating and capital needs, and maintain appropriate levels of operating and capital reserves. WHEREAS, the District the sewer rates were based on a Comprehensive Sewer Service User Fee and Charges Study developed by Tuckfield & Associates (Tuckfield), which identified the estimated funds necessary to operate, maintain, replace and upgrade the District's sewage collection system to adequate capacity and make repairs mandated through the Waste Discharge Requirements of the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board. WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 42 established rates for a five-year period commencing with Fiscal Year (FY) 19-20 through FY 23-24 pursuant to Proposition 218 (1996) and the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act (Govt. Code 53750-53758). WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on April 1, 2024, the Board considered a preliminary report from Tuckfield regarding establishing new fees for the next five-year period and at that time the Board determined to forgo the rate study and keep and extend the rates established in Ordinance No. 42 for FY 23-24 going forward until a new study determines that new rates are required. NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors does hereby ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1: CONTINUATION OF FY 23-24 RATES.** Pursuant to provisions of California Health & Safety Code Section 5471, the following sewer service charges established for FY 23-24 by Ordinance No. 42 for each property use type shall continue for FY 24-25 and subsequent years until a new study determines that new rates need to be established:

**SECTION 3:** All provisions of Ordinance No. 42 not affected hereby shall remain in effect.
